

The A,B,C's of Prayer:

- ❖ Know who you are praying to
- ❖ Come to know the Lords will, so that you don't ask amiss.
- ❖ Have Faith
- ❖ When you pray, believe
- ❖ Pray with expectancy of receiving
- ❖ Don't waver in your request
- ❖ Don't doubt God's answer



To Know Him:

Know ye that the Lord he is God: it is he that hath **made us**, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. (Ps 100:3)

Creator:

In the beginning God **created** the heaven and the earth. (Gen 1:1)

So God **created** man in his own image, in the image of God **created** he him; male and female **created** he them. (Gen 1:27)

For by him were all things **created**, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were **created** by him, and for him: (Col 1:16)

Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast **created** all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were **created**. (Rev 4:11)

Deliverer

For he shall **deliver** the needy when he crieth; the poor also, and him that hath no helper. (Ps 72:12)

Redeemer

As for our **redeemer**, the Lord of hosts is his name, the Holy One of Israel. (Isa 47:4)

Thus saith the Lord, thy **Redeemer**, the Holy One of Israel; I am the Lord thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go. (Isa 48:17)

Helper

So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my **helper**, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me. (Heb 13:6)

Strength

He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth **strength**. (Isa 40:29)

Peace

And the **peace of God**, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. (Phil 4:7)

And Savior

For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the **Saviour** of all men, specially of those that believe. (1 Tim 4:10)

...grow in grace, and in the knowledge of our Lord and **Saviour** Jesus Christ.

To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen.

Knowing His Will:

And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we **ask** any thing according to his will, he heareth us: (1John 5:14)

Also Read James 4:3

Have Faith:

But **without faith** it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. (Heb 11:6)

Pray-Believing:

Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye **pray, believe** that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. (Mark 11:24)

And all things, what soever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive. (Matt 21:22)

Expectation:

My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my **expectation** is from him. (Ps 62:5)

Wavering/Double Minded:

But let him ask in faith, nothing **wavering**. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. (James 1:6)

Also Read James 1:8

Doubting/Unbelief:

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not **doubt** in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. (Mark 11:23)**Also, Matt 13:58**
