#1) COME TO CHRIST



To "Come to God" is to approach or acknowledge Him in faith as Saviour, the only one that can truly deliver us from the "whatever".

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that comes to God must believe that he is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.

Hebrews 11:6

"Believe that he is" means to believe that He exists, that he is real, and that he exists in the man Christ Jesus.

The reward is His love, His grace, His mercy, and His acceptance of you right where you are. You can approach God with expectancy!

#2) Repent



To "repent" means to turn away from, to do a 180 from everything that has had you bound, and everything that has held you captive.

..." Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, and saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel".

Mark 1:14-15

"And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commands all men every where to repent". Acts 17:30

"Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord.

Acts 3:19

#3) BE BAPTIZED



Baptism is an open act of surrender, repentance and confession of a personal need for cleansing, that only God can accomplish through the precious blood of His Son Jesus Christ.

He that believes and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believes not shall be damned. Mark 16:16

And there went out unto him all the land of Judea, and they of Jerusalem, and were all baptized of him in the river of Jordan, confessing their sins. Mark 1:5

Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in the newness of life. Romans 6:4

<mark>...<u>they were baptized in the name of</u> <u>the Lord Jesus</u>. Acts 19:5</mark>

#4) BE FILLED WITH THE HOLY GHOST



The "Holy Ghost" is the awesome, powerful, joyful and comforting spirit of Christ abiding in you, to lead, teach and keep you.

"Which things we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teaches, but which the Holy Ghost teaches; comparing spiritual things with spiritual".

1 Corinthians 2:13

... "the disciples were filled with joy, and with the Holy Ghost". Acts 13:52

... "ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me . . . unto the uttermost part of the earth" Acts 1:8

#5) Speaking in Tongues as the spirit of God gives utterance.

"Tongues" is an internal confirmation of Christ in you. The confirmation takes place in you and is for you. Don't fool yourself. Wait for it!

"And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues as the spirit gave them utterance". Acts 2:3-4

"For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God" . . . Acts 10:46

#6) Continue

And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayer. Acts 2:42 Study to show yourself approved unto God... 2 Timothy 2:15
